



FIVE LAWS OF TOMORROW THINKERS

25 And the first came out red. He was like a hairy garment all over; so they called his name Esau.
26 Afterward his brother came out, and his hand took hold of Esau's heel; so his name was called Jacob. Isaac was sixty years old when she bore them.
27 So the boys grew. And Esau was a skillful hunter, a man of the field; but Jacob was a mild man, dwelling in tents.
28 And Isaac loved Esau because he ate of his game, but Rebekah loved Jacob.
29 Now Jacob cooked a stew; and Esau came in from the field, and he was weary.
30 And Esau said to Jacob, "Please feed me with that same red stew, for I am weary." Therefore his name was called Edom.
31 But Jacob said, "Sell me your birthright as of this day."
32 And Esau said, "Look, I am about to die; so what is this birthright to me?"
33 Then Jacob said, "Swear to me as of this day." So he swore to him, and sold his birthright to Jacob.
34 And Jacob gave Esau bread and stew of lentils; then he ate and drank, arose, and went his way. Thus Esau despised his birthright. **Genesis 25:25-34 (NKJV)**

The phrase: "Tomorrow Thinkers" may recall the Bible verse that says "Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself" (Matthew 6:34 KJV). However, "take no thought" does not apply to a tomorrow thinker because literally means "not being anxious". A tomorrow thinker has his tomorrow in view, hence he is not anxious or worried about his tomorrow.

Law is defined as a rule of action established by authority; a statement or formula expressing the constant order of certain phenomena.

In this article, we will be discussing five laws of the constant order of tomorrow thinkers.

Law 1: Be Like God

13 And God said to Noah, "The end of all flesh has come before Me, for the earth is filled with violence through them; and behold, I will destroy them with the earth.
14 Make yourself an ark of gopherwood; make rooms in the ark, and cover it inside and outside with pitch.
Genesis 6:13-14

God plans ahead. God told Noah to build an ark hundreds of years before the rain fell and Noah began building immediately. Noah could have said, "God, what are You talking about? It does not rain, instead, dew falls to moisten the earth and make it suitable for vegetation. Where will the Ark stand?" Also, people would have laughed at Noah and mocked him while he built, but he went ahead with God's plan.

John's vision of the Marriage Supper of the Lamb in Revelations 19 is many years to come, yet, God has given specifications concerning what it will be like. If God our Father, the creator of heaven and earth is a tomorrow thinker, no less is expected of us.

Law 2: Control Your Appetite

32 And Esau said, "Look, I am about to die; so what is this birthright to me?"
Genesis 25:32

Esau, unlike Jacob, did not recognize the importance of his birthright because he was not a tomorrow thinker. He believed that his birthright would come after his father's death which would be many years ahead, so he said, "I am about to die; so what is this birthright to me?" He sacrificed his birthright on the altar of his immediate need. He was unable to control his appetite.

There are several classifications for what a person may have an appetite for. One of such is food. Some Christians eat like there is no tomorrow. Let me tell you a story my kid brother once told me. A man was seen eating from a big bowl of *eba*. So, he was asked, "Bros, this *eba* is big o, can you finish it?" The brother replied, "By the grace of God". Christians should be more appealed to the grace of God when it comes to fasting. Every time God provided food for His people, He did it twice a day: morning and evening. Do not eat irresponsibly. Control your appetite.

Some Christians can't control their appetite for fashion. They must wear whatever is considered fashionable or in vogue regardless of appearance. Don't be out of fashion but dress modestly and decently.

Another form of uncontrolled appetite is sex. Many Christians suffer from one or more sexually related diseases. It's worse when they are married and are involved in extramarital activities. It is even more terrible when Pastors are involved. They get sexually involved with the sheep that God has placed under their care. Have you ever heard a Christian boast about sleeping with their pastor? Other examples are those who live with people they are not married to. The list

goes on. No one starts being drunk in one day. Control your appetite. Sex outside of marriage is a sin. Make the Word of God lord over your life and you will have control over your appetites.

Law 3: Invest In Your Tomorrow

31 But Jacob said, "Sell me your birthright as of this day."
Genesis 25:31

If Jacob took the time to prepare a pot of pottage, it shows that he must have been hungry; yet, he was willing to continue being hungry and trade his pottage for something in the future. Invest in your tomorrow. The Bible says that a good man leaves an inheritance for his children (Proverbs 13:22). A lot of Christians grow old and tell their children, "I was doing the work of the Lord, that is why I don't have an inheritance for you" while being fully aware of the truth that they'd spent their active years indulging in their selfish appetites and cravings. Invest in your children, invest in your business, invest in other people and invest in the Gospel. Giving to the gospel is the best kind of investment you can make.

Do not waste resources. Genesis 25:32 says, "And Esau said, 'Look, I am about to die; so what is this birthright to me?'" He was not a tomorrow thinker; he had the attitude of the prodigal son. Prodigal means *wasteful*. Don't be a "waster". If you waste what you should sow, you will have nothing to reap.

Law 4: Recognize The Value Or The Importance Of Empowerment

33 Then Jacob said, "Swear to me as of this day." So he swore to him, and sold his birthright to Jacob.
Genesis 25:33

The New English Translation says, "Swear an oath to me now". This means empower me. In this case, his empowerment was the oath.

Regardless of your position or expertise, you can't do everything, get partners.

Jacob was a man who understood empowerment. When Isaac said to Esau, "...Make me savory food, such as I love", and Rebekah overheard him, she told Jacob to go in his place with the food that she would prepare, but Jacob started asking questions: "How am I going to do that? My brother is hairy, and I'm smooth. What if I bring a curse on myself?" Jacob wasn't afraid, he was a master negotiator. He was trying to tie up all the loose ends and in the end, he got into partnership with his mother (Genesis 27:1-17) and got the blessing. Jacob also used the tool of service as a point for negotiation and subsequently empowerment when he worked for his uncle, Laban and God blessed him (Genesis 30:25-41;31).

Empower yourself for tomorrow. No matter how small your company is, register it and sign contracts even when you work with fellow Christians. This does not mean you do not trust them; it means you are making room for God to bless you. It is a tragedy to live below the standard that God has already allocated to you.

Law 5: Tomorrow Thinkers Rule The World

28 Therefore may God give you Of the dew of heaven, Of the fatness of the earth, And plenty of grain and wine.

29 Let peoples serve you, And nations bow down to you. Be master over your brethren, And let your mother's sons bow down to you. Cursed be everyone who curses you, And blessed be those who bless you!"

Genesis 27:28-29

A lot of pastors and preachers are not tomorrow thinkers. If a pastor says, "I'm not satisfied anymore with the way things are done in my church", and he leaves, opens his church and does the exact same thing, what then was his dissatisfaction? He is not a tomorrow thinker. If God gives you a distinct vision, you should be able to articulate it properly to be able to rule your world.

Let us examine some of the blessings Isaac bestowed on Jacob: "*May God give you of the dew of Heaven*". Rain is seasonal, whereas dew is always rarely seasonal. That is God's constant favour in your life. "*The fatness of the earth*" talks about the richness of both quantity and quality. When it talks about "*Plenty of grain and wine*", grain is a primary product but wine is a processed product. This means that both your primary and processed products will be so much that you'll be able to export and operate on industrial level. There will be no limit to the promotion of those who will understand these laws and stand by them.

Prophecy

I prophesy to you that this will be your portion in the name of Jesus Christ.

You will build churches, schools, hospitals and whatever God has given you vision for, and people from all over the world will come because of its rare qualities. When this happens, your brethren, including your enemies, will bow before you. Then, you will rule the world.

2024 MINISTRY CODES

Ministry is defined as service to others, specifically within the body of Christ. A "minister" is a servant of God. The word is derived from the Greek word: *diakonos* {dee-ak'-on-os}.

The Merriam-Webster's Dictionary defines "code" as a systematic body of laws especially one given a statutory force; a system of principles or rules that is moral code.

A lot of anointed ministers don't understand ministerial codes, ethics, administration, and protocol, and it is limiting their impact. Here are some 2024 ministry codes you should prayerfully consider. Remember, ministry is more than preaching and praying.

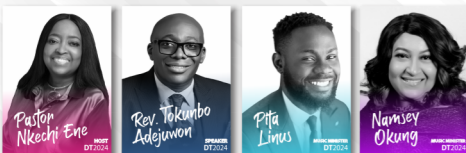
1. Plan your services. Draw up a programme for the men, women, youth, children, and other arms in line with the year's theme and the ministry's vision and mission. (Proverbs 16:3)
2. Prepare a budget and work within the budget. This will help you not to get into debt. Remember, men are sizes and life is in phases. Live your size today. A great future awaits you. (Luke 14:28-33)
3. Create time to rest. "No ministry on Mondays" is my recommendation. You can resume on Tuesday. If you are under a minister, your pastor may approve your annual vacation. Lead pastors should also have annual leave to rest and be renewed. (Genesis 2:1-3)
4. A vision is the big picture, your plan are the practical and pragmatic steps to getting the vision fulfilled. Write down your plans and put a timeline on when to achieve them, even if you don't meet them. It will serve as a checklist. (Habakkuk 2:2-3)
5. Evaluate the men and material God has blessed you with and make maximum use of what you have now. Don't complain and don't stress yourself, growth will come. (Proverbs 27:23)
6. Go to only meetings that God is leading you to attend, or the ones that will make an impact. You cannot honour every invitation. You cannot be everywhere. Everyone cannot accept or understand your ministry. Some will even leave you; don't kill yourself. They left Jesus too, but He fulfilled His calling. Scrap meetings that have outlived their usefulness. (Proverbs 13:20)
7. In ministry, you cannot handle everything. Ask for help. Create teams and delegate. Structure your ministry into departments with team heads and just supervise them. For example, music and media, admin and finance, ushering and protocol, maintenance and technical, cleaning and decoration, evangelism and follow up, charity and welfare, prayer force, counselling and visitation, etc.
8. Do not attack giving. You need all the money you can get, but do not manipulate anyone or use fraudulent means to get support. You are a holy child of God.
9. Expand your ministry partnership beyond your immediate surroundings. Connect with partners from far and near or you will be limited. God is your source, but men are the channels. God wants you to depend on Him not your congregation. (Philippians 4:19)
10. Live where you can afford and drive what you can afford. Enrol your children in a school you can afford. Your big days are coming.
11. In ministry, not everyone is called to be a pastor. If you are not called to pastor, do ministry, and don't put yourself under pressure. Reinhard Bonnke was not a pastor neither was Billy Graham; but they made impact. Benny Hinn had to even leave pastoring to do ministry. So, stay in the will of God even if you must shut down the church.
12. Don't limit your ministry to those who attend your church. Go to the prisons, hospitals, campuses, and markets. Use media and music, literature, videos, food, and medical outreaches. Go for evangelism using the methods and patterns that work for you. (Mark 16:15)
13. While doing ministry, your wife or husband who is not called should have a career or run a business. Do not force them into ministry like is the norm now among couples. (Ephesians 4:10-12)
14. You are not competing with anyone. Just run your race. The most important people are those you are sent to minister to; every other invitation is secondary, so stay focused. (Acts 20:28)
15. Document events, encounters, messages, meetings and answered prayers, etc. You will need them some day. (Romans 15:4)
16. Spend quality and long hours in prayers, especially in other tongues. It kills depression, keeps you focused and makes you sensitive to the promptings and leadings of the Holy Spirit. (Ephesians 5:18)
17. Live sin and scandal free. Be honest, faithful, consistent, reliable, and trustworthy in all your dealings.
18. Spend quality time with your spouse. Sex, communication, and money are important pillars that will keep your marriage. Invest in them in your marriage.

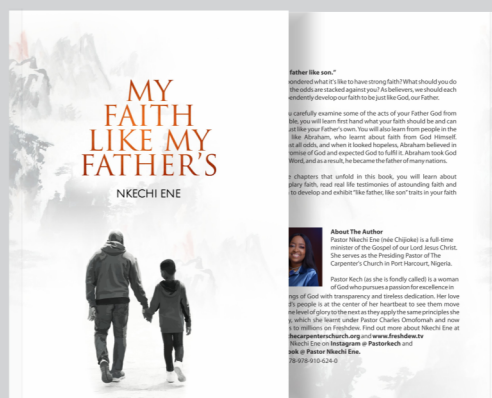

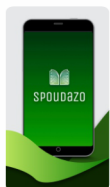
